7th Cambridge Scout Group 531 Dover St S Cambridge Ontario N3H 1L8

The 7th. Cambridge Scout Group, was formed in February 1935 by Rev. Edward Hartleib and Scouter William Cockman, as the St. Clement's Roman Catholic 2nd. Preston Scout Group.

It received its original charter September 30th. 1935, with William Cockman as the first Scoutmaster. He had 25 boys in his group, and they met in St. Clement's Church basement. In 1940 a cub pack was formed. The Scout-Guide Mothers Auxiliary was organized in 1944.

Expanding rapidly, close to 100 boys, the group needed larger quarters, and in 1948 land for the erection of a Scout Hall was purchased on Dover Street South, between Vine Street and Sherring Street. Framework went up in 1949, the interior was completed and the hall officially opened in 1950. With great effort the debt on the building was liquidated just five years later.

A deed to the RC Scout Hall on Dover Street South was turned over to Rev. P.J Meyers, pastor of St. Clement's Church at the mortgage burning ceremony in 1955. The Galt Knights Of Columbus, Council 2184, sponsored the St. Clement's 2nd. Preston Scout Group, from its inception in 1935, until 1960.

Sponsorship was then transferred to Preston's newly formed, Msgr. Paul J. Meyer, Knights Of Columbus Council 4916 in 1960 and continues to this day. In 1973 when Preston became Cambridge, the 2nd. Preston Group, was renamed the St. Clement's RC 7th. Cambridge Scout Group. It is the second longest continuously run group in Cambridge.

Many Knights Of Columbus Members of Msgr. Paul J. Meyer, Council 4916, (too many to name here), have been involved in the St. Clement's RC 2nd. Preston Scout Group and the St. Clement's RC 7th. Cambridge Scout Group, over the years, and

are still involved to this day. Some were Cubs and Scouts, Venturers, Rovers, Leaders, Scoutmasters, Committee Members, helped build the Scout Hall, etc., etc.

The Knights association with the 7th. Cambridge Scout Group continues with current Council members, Robert MacDonald, Joseph Beke, and Rudy Bauer as Group Committee Trustees, and Leonard Comeau, as Group Commissioner,

Our Grand Knight and our Group's Trustees regularly attend our annual Scout's Family Banquet in February.

Our Council's annual sponsorship donation is much appreciated and needed to help offset operational cost of the Group. Currently the 7th. Cambridge Scout Group has 8 Cub Scouts with 2 Leaders, meeting every Tuesday at 6.30 pm, and 12 Beaver Scouts, with 3 Leaders meeting every Wednesday at 6.15 pm. in our Dover Street Scout Hall.
