The Knights of Columbus again set annual records for charitable contributions and volunteer hours, showing itself to be one of the most efficient and effective organizations in the world for helping the poor and the most

needy when and where they need it most.

The results of the Orders Survey of Fraternal Activity, announced on June 9 by Supreme Knight Carl A. Anderson during the State Deputies Meeting in New Haven, showed that the Knights of Columbus gave a total of \$154.7 million to charitable causes in the year ending Dec. 31, 2010, an increase of more than \$3 million from the previous year. Knights also volunteered more than 70 million hours of charitable works last year, nearly 800,000 more than in 2009. (Knightline July 2011)

GK Danny Schmalz presided over the election of Board of Directors:

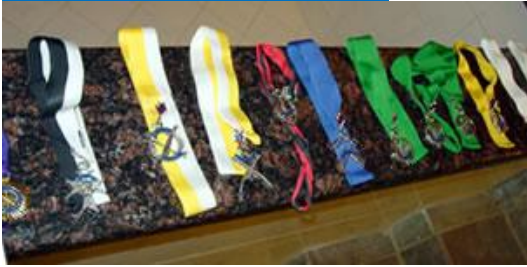

COUNCIL OFFICERS:**



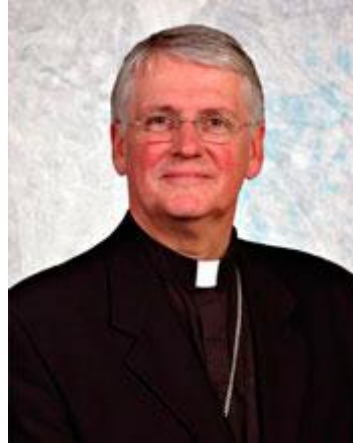
