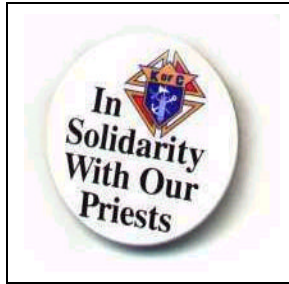

Grant Ertel will be our presenter. He will do two workshops. One on the Grand Knights position and one on the role of the Financial Secretary. All members are invited to attend.

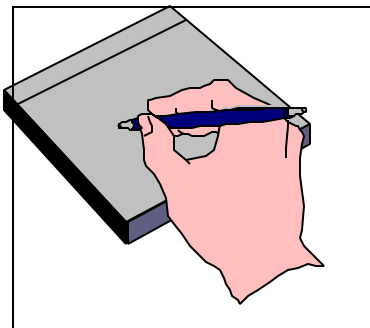

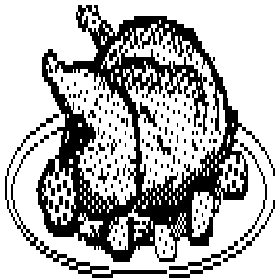
