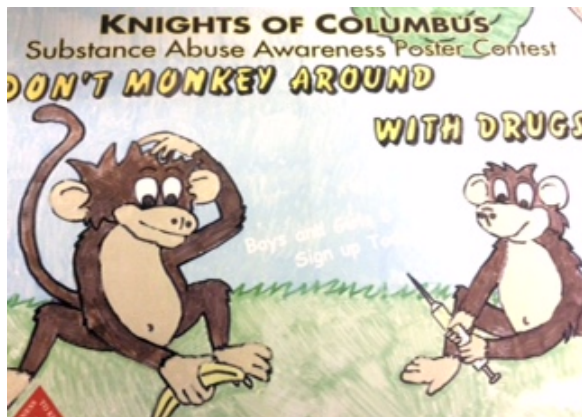


Save the date Friday Dec. 16 at 6:00 p.m. for an enjoyable evening at our Council Pot Luck.
